**Hebrews 10** A reminder to the early church that Jesus Christ is the great High Priest, who continues God's covenant with his people and offers forgiveness for the world's sins. Christ calls us to have true hearts with which to work for a better world.

**Mark 13.1-8** Jesus lived in violent times and warns that in times of strife when " Nations rise against nations", it is important to remain faithful to Jesus message, calling us all to work for justice and peace.
